

Dress Code 2021-2022

All **Kindergarten through Sixth-Grade** students at St. John the Baptist Catholic School are expected to wear the school uniform during the school day. The following rules are in place to ensure we show respect for the school, ourselves, and others through our appearance.

Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays	<p>>White, navy, (gray or red also for middle school) short or long sleeved polo shirts (with or without St. John's logo)</p> <p>>White, navy, (gray or red also for middle school) sweaters- including SJB logo sweatshirts (non-hooded) and ½ zip pullovers.</p> <p>>White oxfords (button up dress shirt)</p> <p><i>-Shirts must remain tucked</i></p> <p><i>*2021-2022 may be the last school year for red shirts and sweaters.</i></p>	<p>>Navy, khaki colored, (gray or black also for middle school) dress pants (no cargo pants or corduroys), capris, walking shorts, skorts, and skirts.</p> <p>>Plaid, tan, navy, or (black or gray also for middle school) jumpers/skirts - plaid sold by Donald's</p> <p><i>>Girls should wear cartwheel shorts or leggings (navy or white) under skirts and jumpers.</i></p> <p><i>>Leggings & jeggings may not be worn without a skirt or jumper.</i></p> <p><i>>Shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers must not come more than 2" above the knee.</i></p> <p><i>*2021-2022 may be the last year for black pants, shorts, or skirts.</i></p>

All Students

Shoes, Sandals, and Socks

Socks must be worn at all times.

Dress shoes and tennis shoes are acceptable.

- *All shoes must have backs or straps.*
- *Shoes must be clean, safe and in good condition.*
- *Tennis shoes with non-marking soles are required for physical education.*
- *Waterproof boots are expected in snowy or wet weather but are not to be worn in the classroom.*
- *No shoes with wheels are allowed.*

Out-of-Uniform Days

There will be out-of-uniform days for special occasions and recognition. The following are prohibited: Sleeveless shirts; low necklines; clothing with offensive words, phrases or pictures; No exposed midriffs; shorts, skirts and dresses more than 2" above the knee; and flip flops. Please, no ripped jeans, or leggings & jeggings worn without a skirt.

Students that do not follow the dress code policy as outlined here will be reminded through the following means of enforcement:

Enforcement

1st offense: A note will be sent home.

2nd offense: A call will be made to the parents/guardians.

3rd offense: Parents/guardians will be called to bring their child a proper uniform. Persistent violations will be addressed by the administration.
